
### Tools and material you'll need


- 1. Craft Knife (X-Acto kife)
- 2. White glue
- 3. Color markers or pencils
- 4. Tweezers
- 5. Paint brush


#### **Useful tips**

- Completely read these instructions before cutting. Make sure you understood all instructions steps
- Detach parts carefully as they are needed
- **Avoid** over application of glue! This may cause paper to wrinkle. Use a paint brush to apply glue on parts
- In some parts, you'll notice some white areas and light gray lines showing how pieces should line up when glued
- When you cut paper, white edges will be apparent. Use a marker or pencil to color these edges, before gluing them
- Mountain fold means printed surface should be on the outside
- Valley fold means printed surface should be on the inside
- Remove parts marked with a red star (\*)
- When building, be sure the glue dries completely before proceeding to the next step


### Head









Assemble the head from bottom to top. Start with piece H7, then join piece H6 and so on. When working with the hair pieces, note they have 'hair fringes' that goes 'outside' the piece.



To join them, imagine a line (red line in picture) that connects the inner parts of the fringes on piece H3. You shoul glue tabs on piece H4 using this line as a guide.

#### **Arms**





Assemble pieces A3 to form a cylinder. Glue part A5 to form the hand. Repeat this process with pieces A4 and A6.


You have the option to build your wizard/wicth with or wothout the robe.


Important: When using the robe, pieces A1 e A2 are not used, otherwise, assemble them to form cylinders as shown above. Then glue them to pieces A3 and A4, respectively.

## Body


To assemble the body, you'll need to join all pieces, one after another, and taking time for them to glue completely.

Start glueing piece H8 (neck) to the head. Then, glue piece B1, B2 and B3.







Important: When NOT using the robe, glue arms to their proper position, BEFORE glueing piece B3 to B2.




# Legs






Assemble the legs starting from piece L1.

Then glue, pieces L2, L4 and L6 for the right leg. And the odd ones for the left leg.





Important: When assembling a witch, glue piece X2 (skirt) around piece L1, below the tabs.

### Robe



Start with piece R1. Then, you'll need to join all pieces (R2 to R8), one after another, and taking time for them to glue completely.







Assemble the sleeves and join them to the robe.


Glue piece R18 to form the cuff and hood. Then glue piece R9 onto it.

Add the robe liner to the sleeves, and body of the robe, as show below.




Then, glue the forearms to their proper position, inside the sleeves.






## **Final Assembling**



Put the robe on the body.



Glue legs tabs inside the body.

Roll part X1 to form a cylinder. This is the wand. Insert and glue it into part A6 holes.
