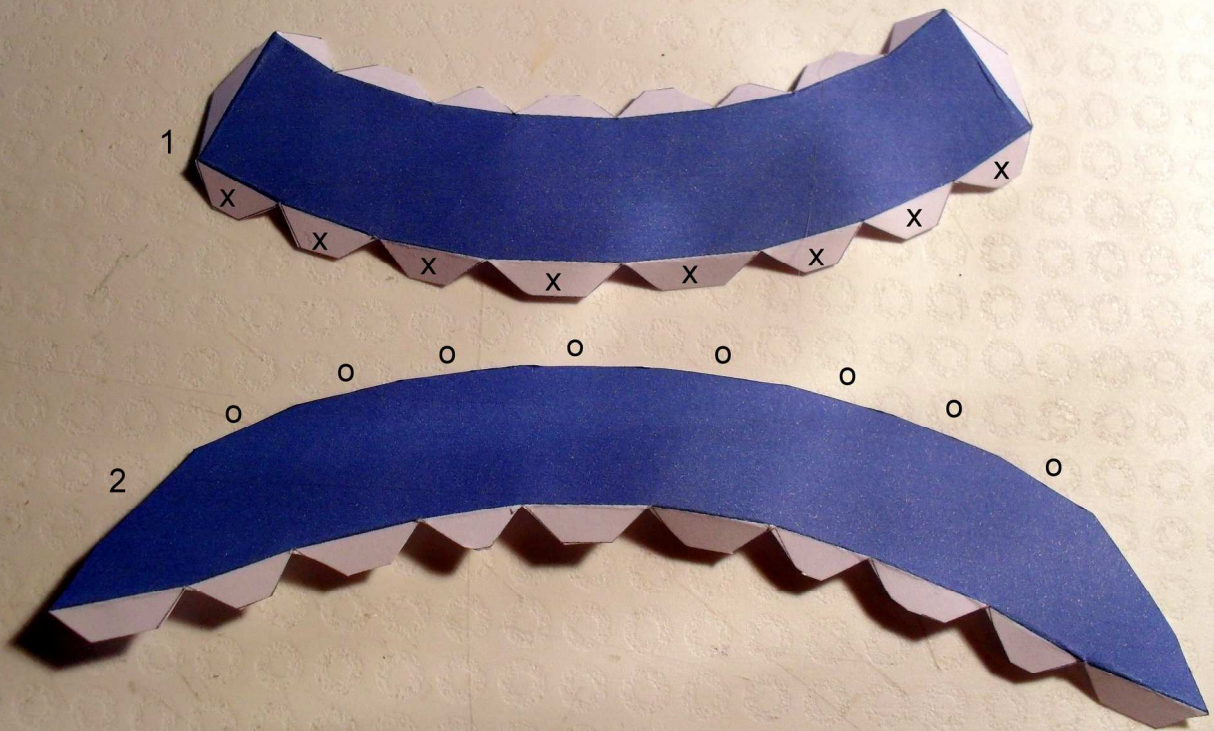
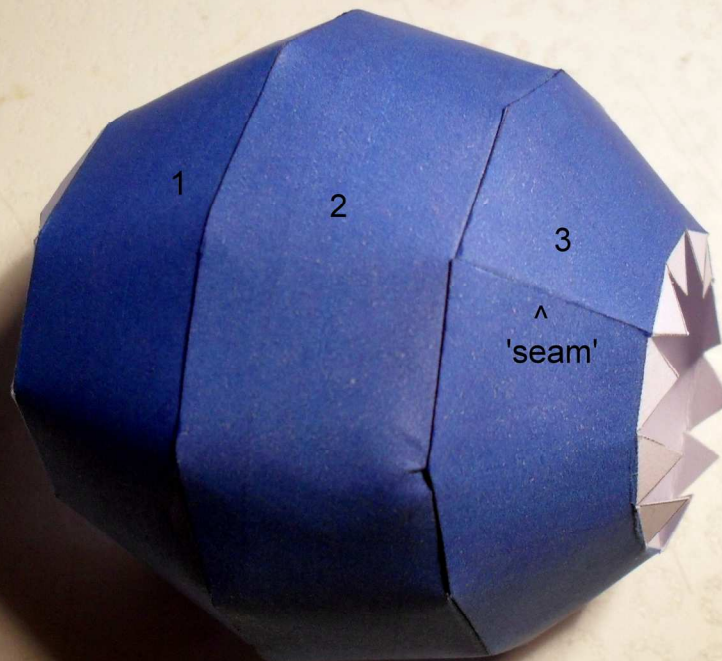


Okay, let's start! Print the four template pages onto thick (120-180gsm) paper, and score all the lines. If you want to build smooth, print off the lineless version and you only need to score the flaps. This is how I will do it.

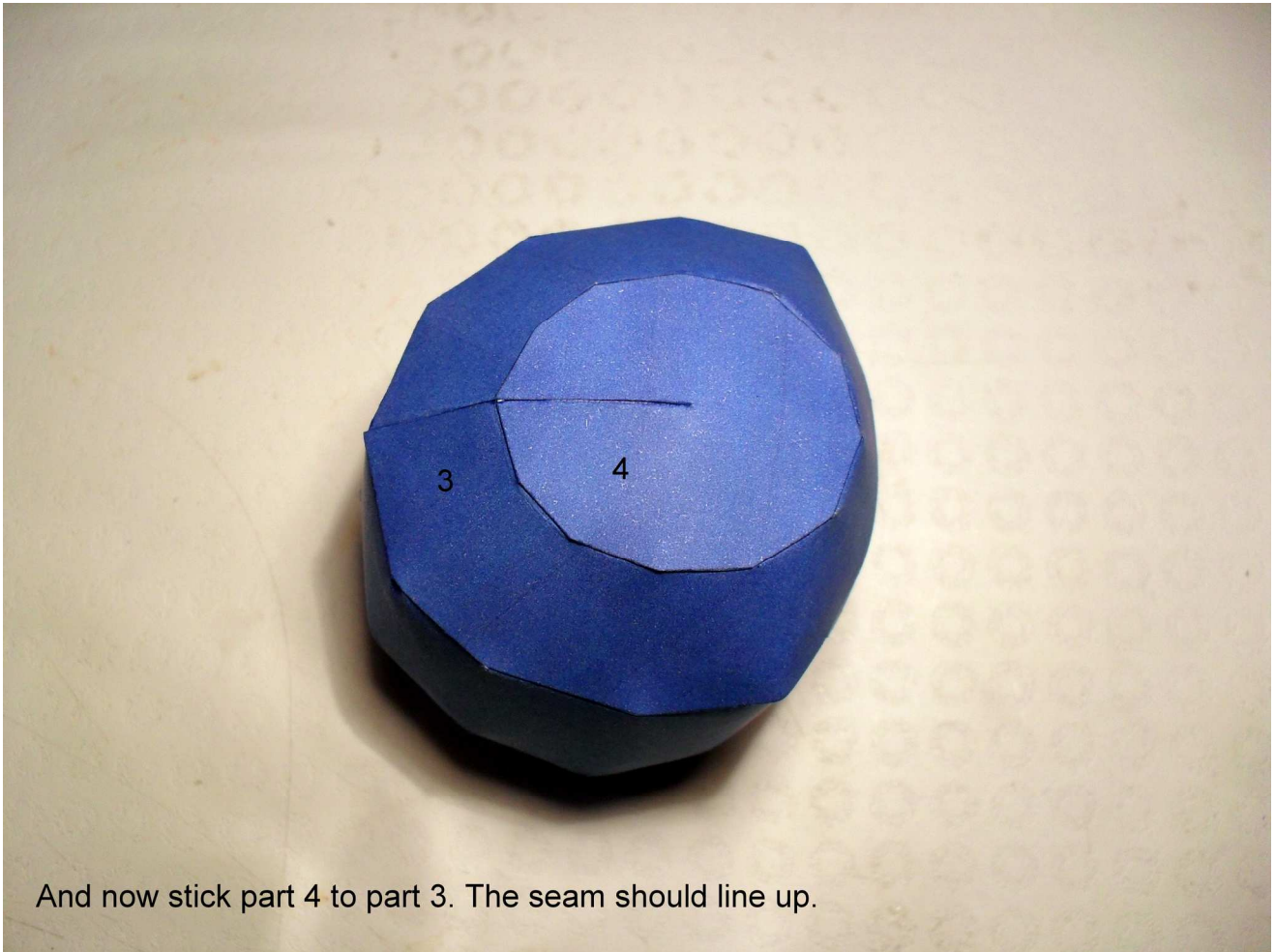


Cut out parts 1 and 2, shown above. Glue the flaps marked 'x', and attach part 1 to the sides of 2, marked with an 'o'.

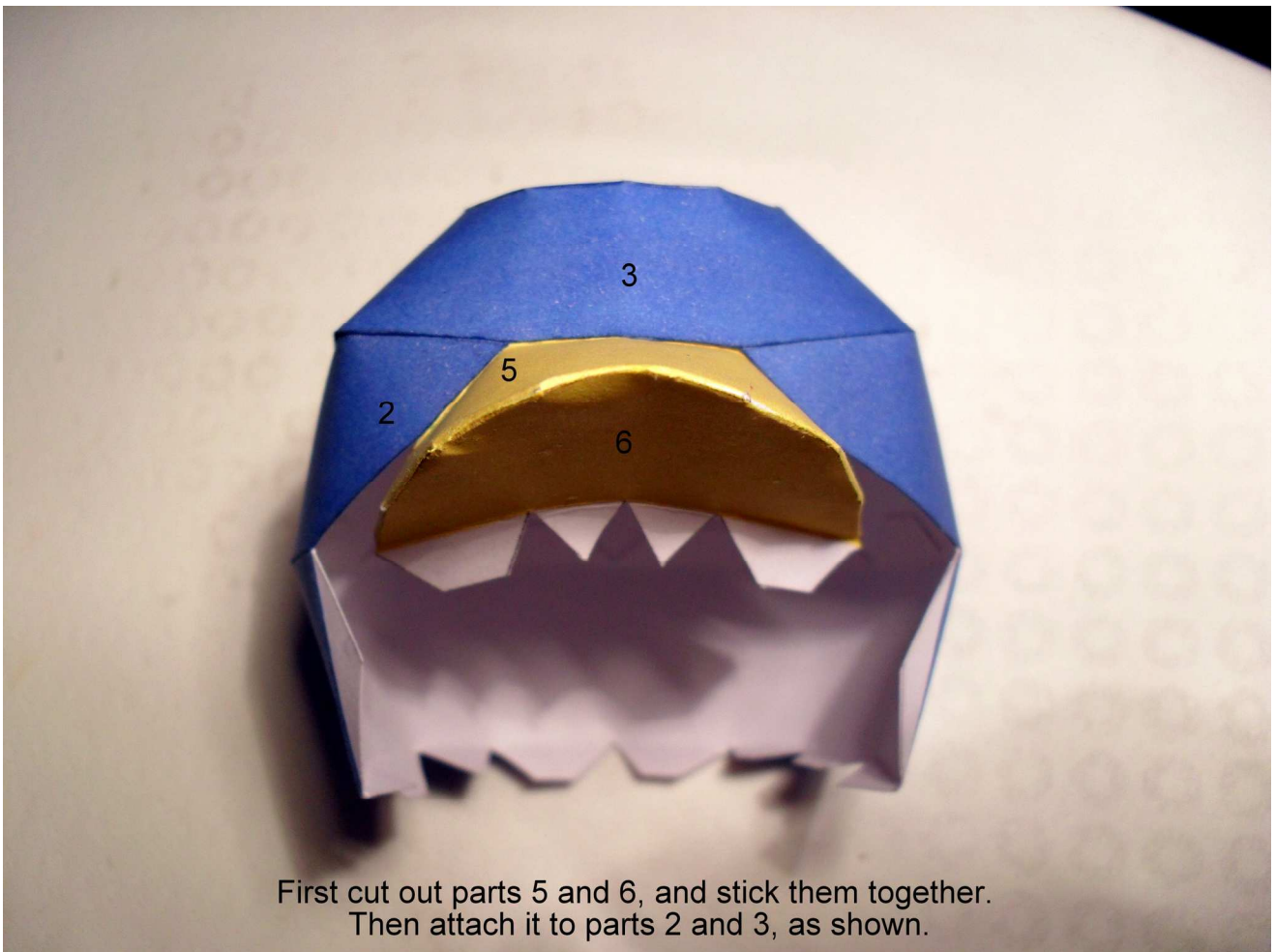


Cut out part 3 and stick it to part 2 in the same way, but make sure the 'seam' of part 3 lines up with the middle of part 2, as shown.



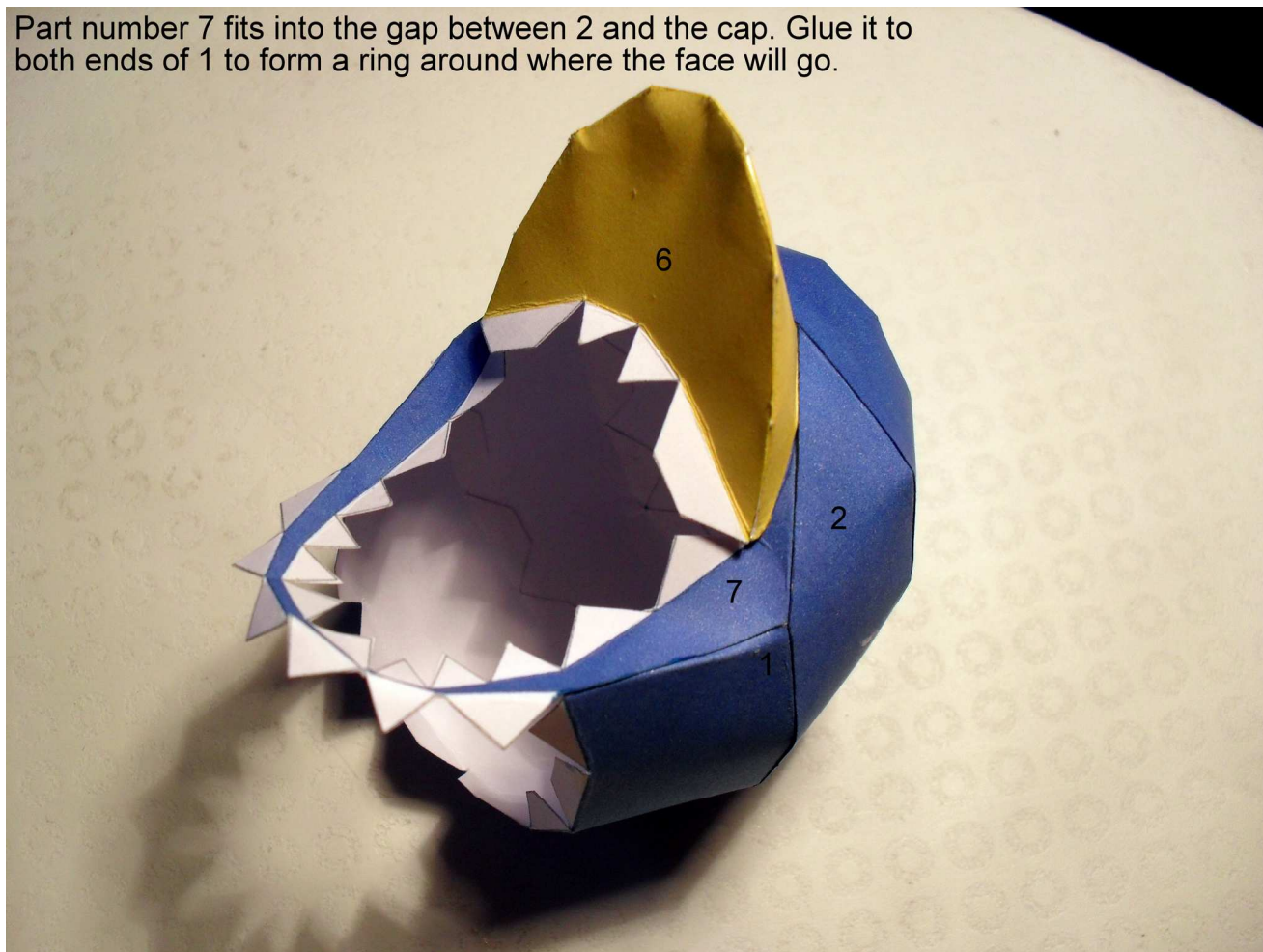


And now stick part 4 to part 3. The seam should line up.



First cut out parts 5 and 6, and stick them together. Then attach it to parts 2 and 3, as shown.

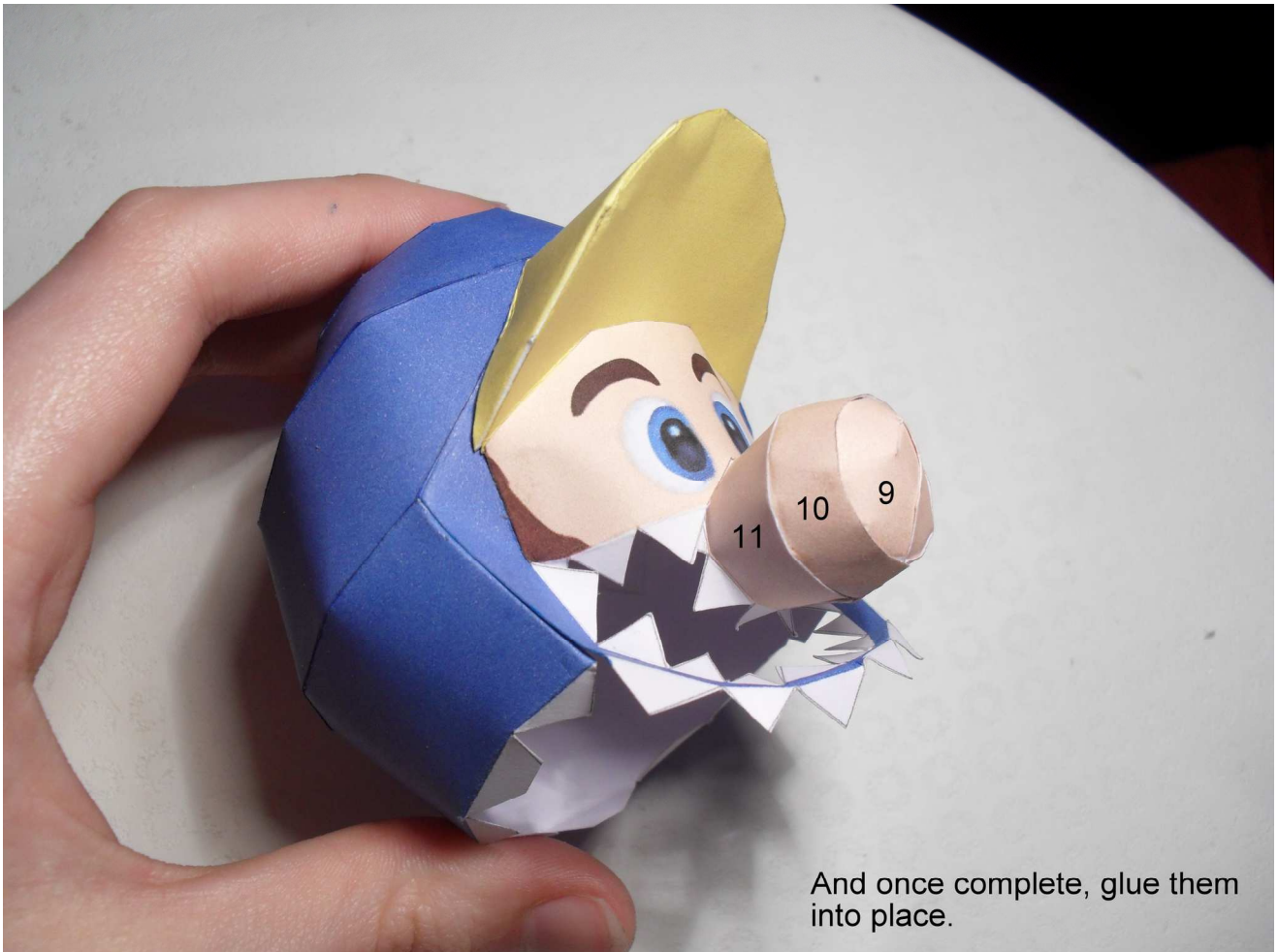
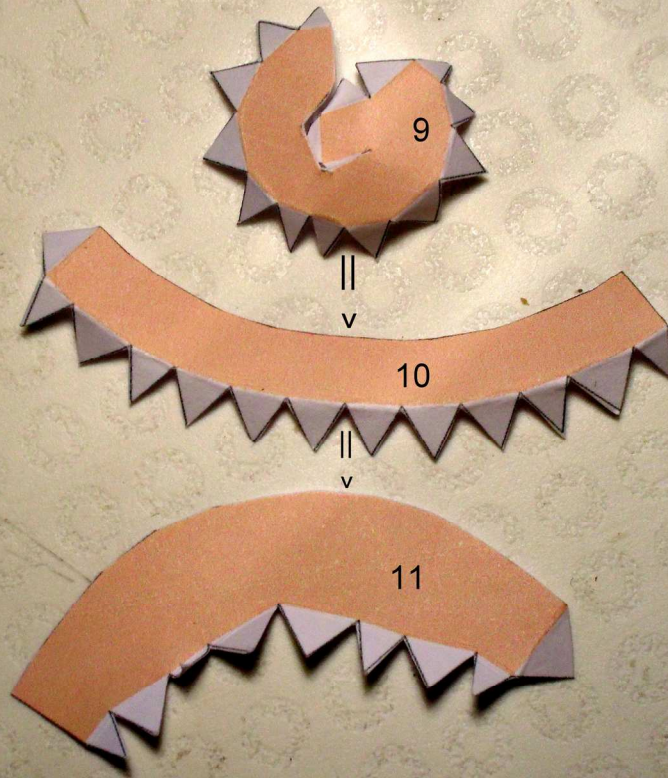
Part number 7 fits into the gap between 2 and the cap. Glue it to both ends of 1 to form a ring around where the face will go.



Part 8 now, and the first of the face pieces. Simply stick it to the bottom of the cap and part 7.



Parts 9, 10 and 11 make up the nose. Cut them out and stick them together.



And once complete, glue them into place.

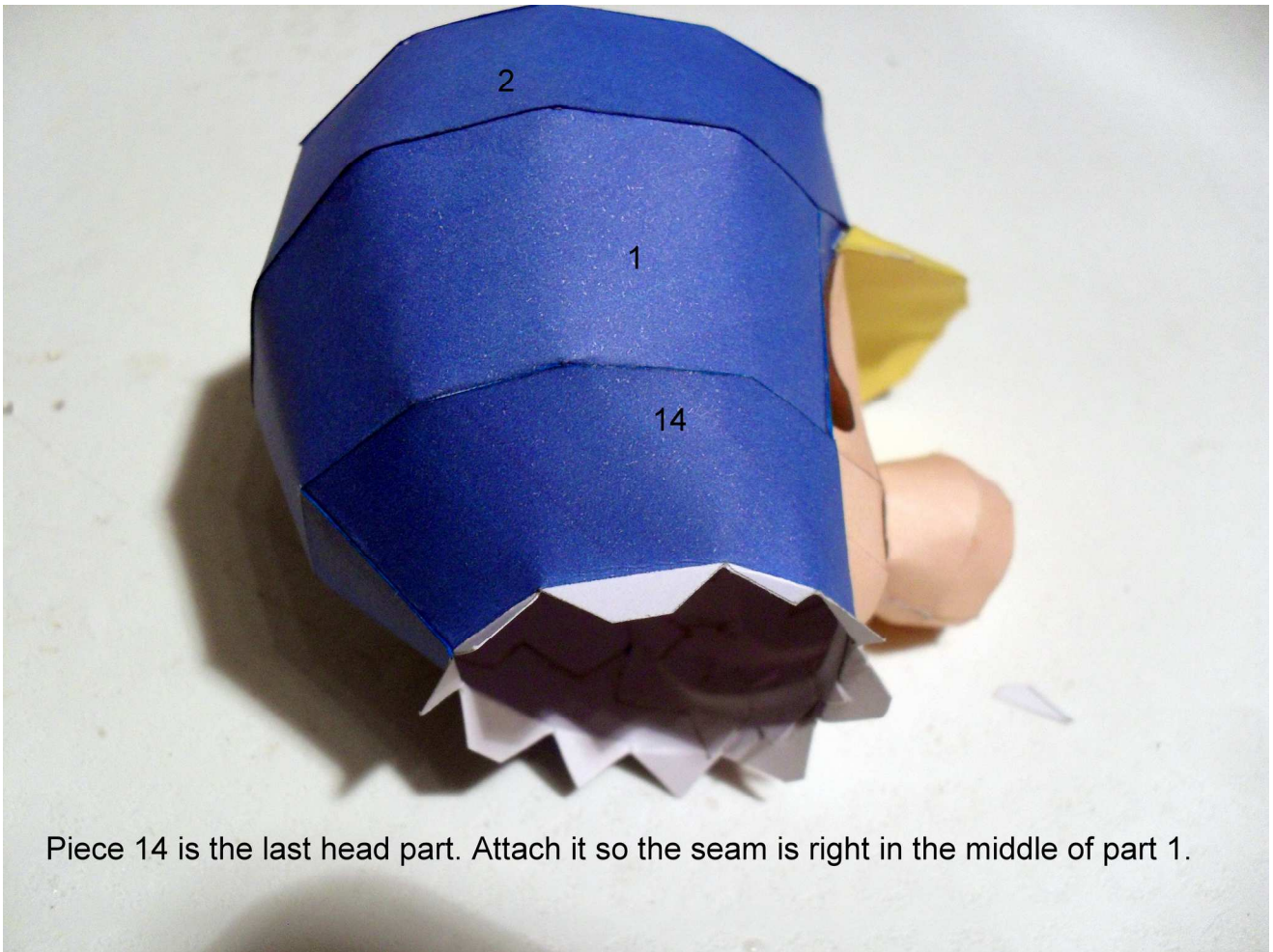




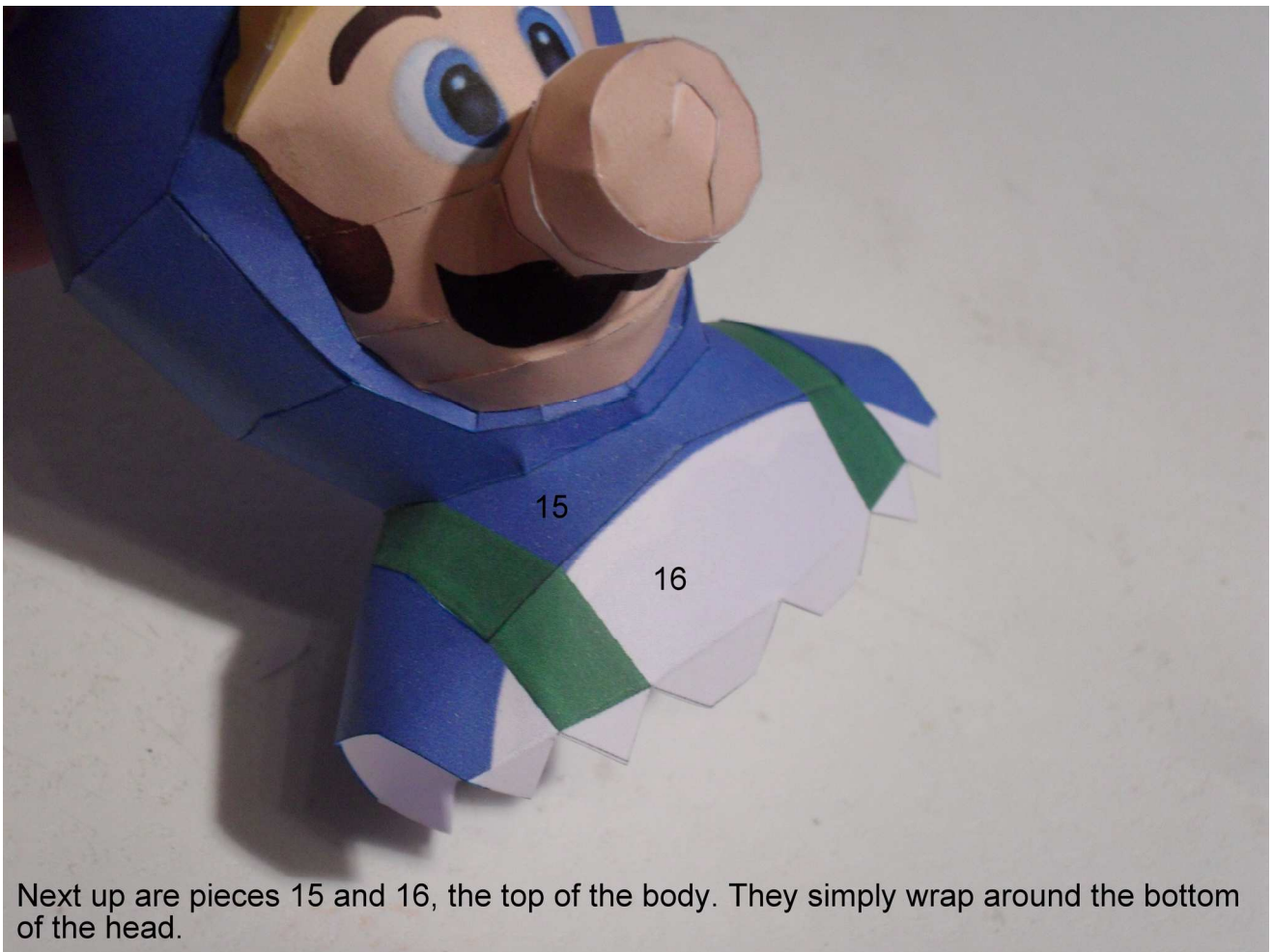
There are two flaps on either side of part 12, glue these down and then stick the piece to the rest of the face.



And now complete the head with piece 13, which should fill the remaining gap.



Piece 14 is the last head part. Attach it so the seam is right in the middle of part 1.

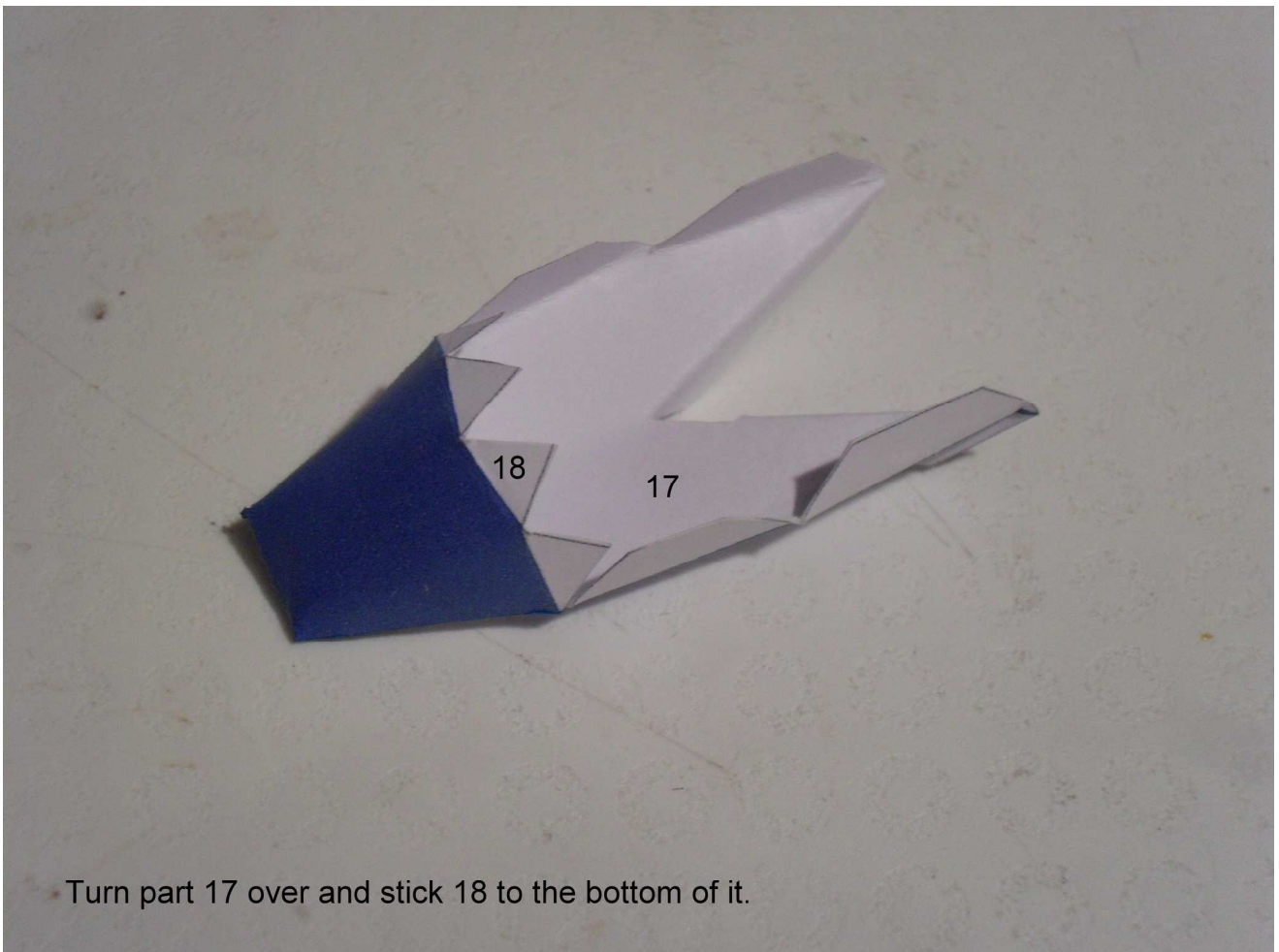


Next up are pieces 15 and 16, the top of the body. They simply wrap around the bottom of the head.

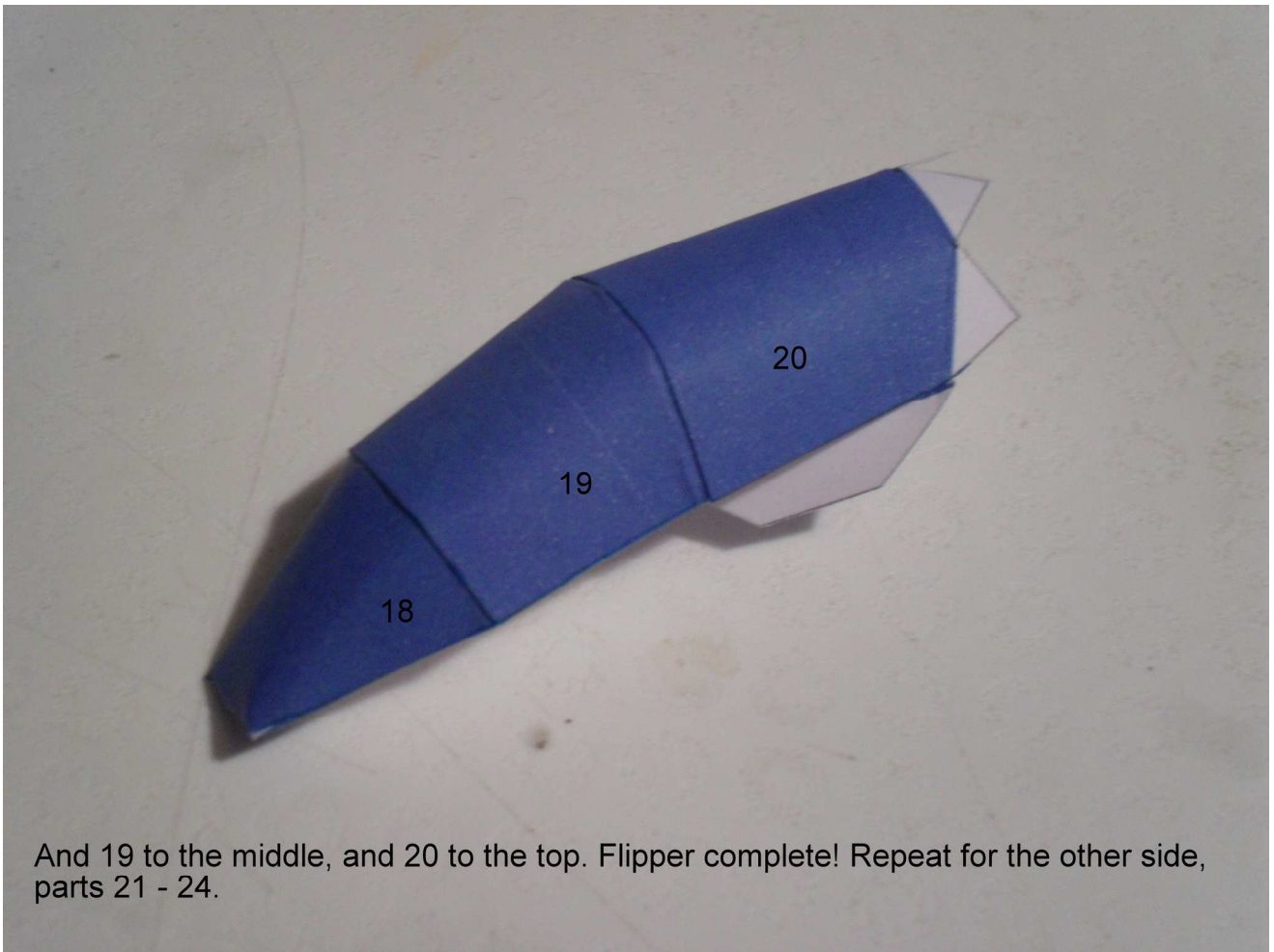




Part 17 is the inside of Luigi's right flipper (your left when he is facing you).



Turn part 17 over and stick 18 to the bottom of it.

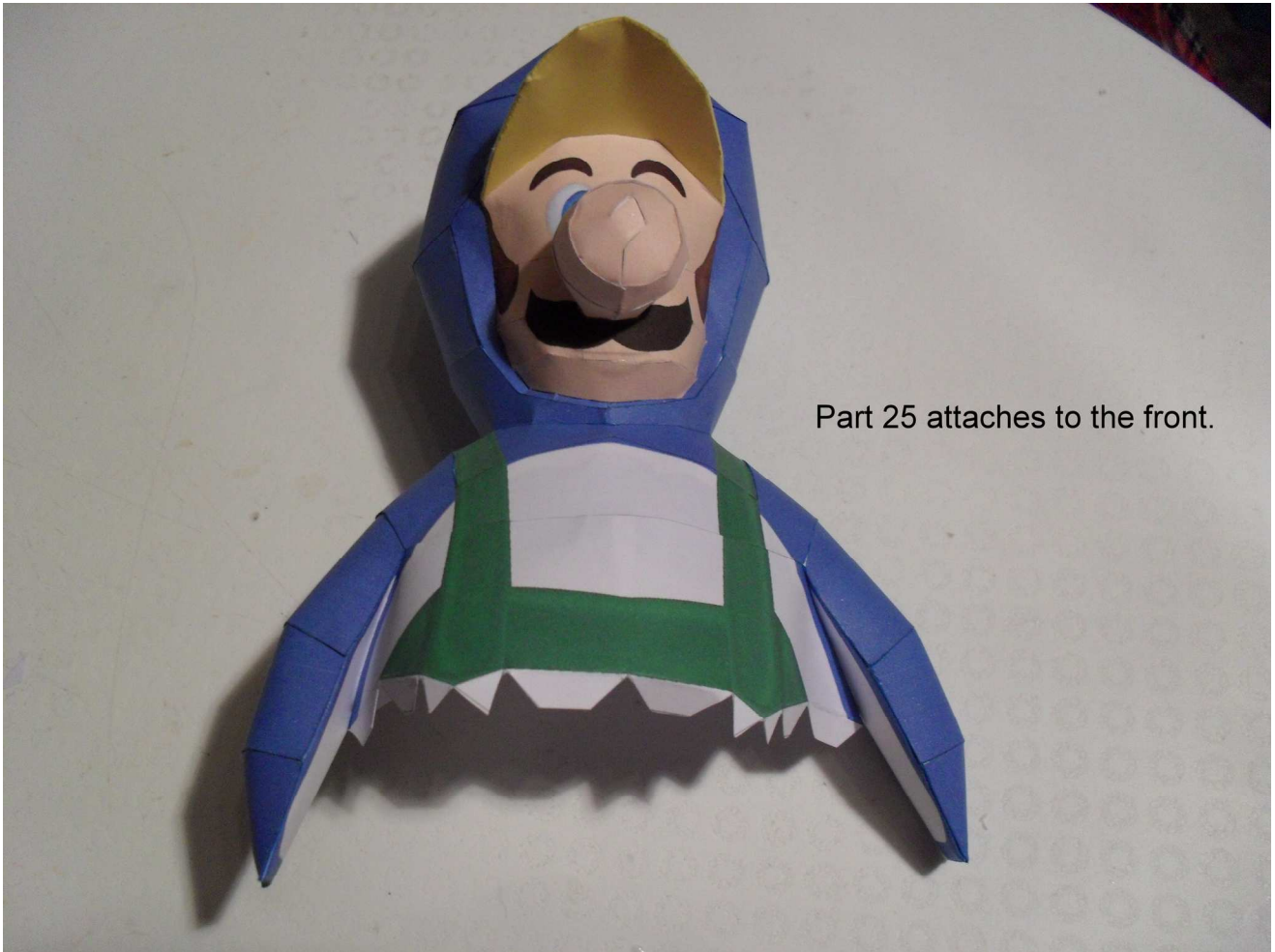


And 19 to the middle, and 20 to the top. Flipper complete! Repeat for the other side, parts 21 - 24.



Glue both flippers to their proper sides.



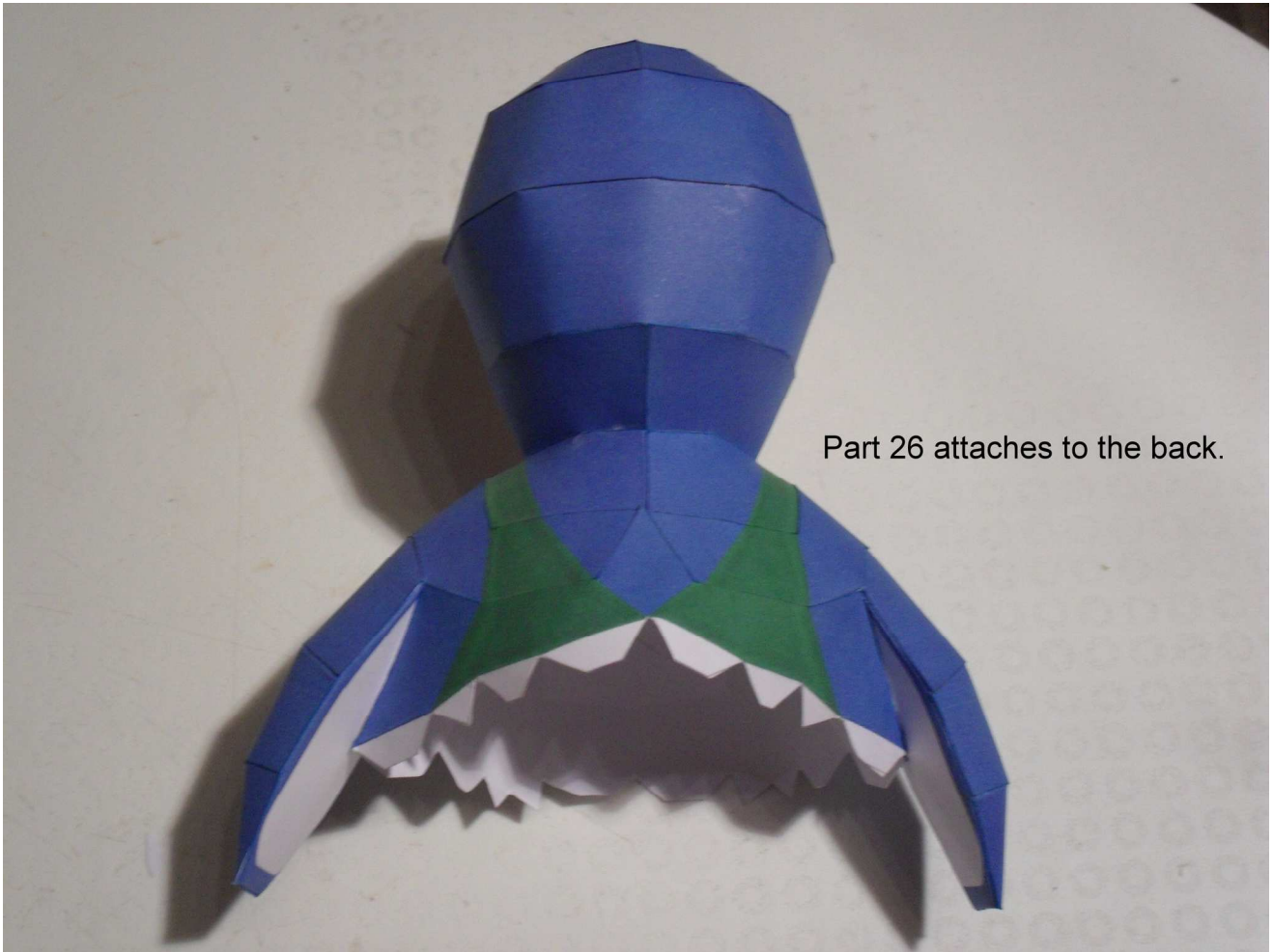


Part 25 attaches to the front.

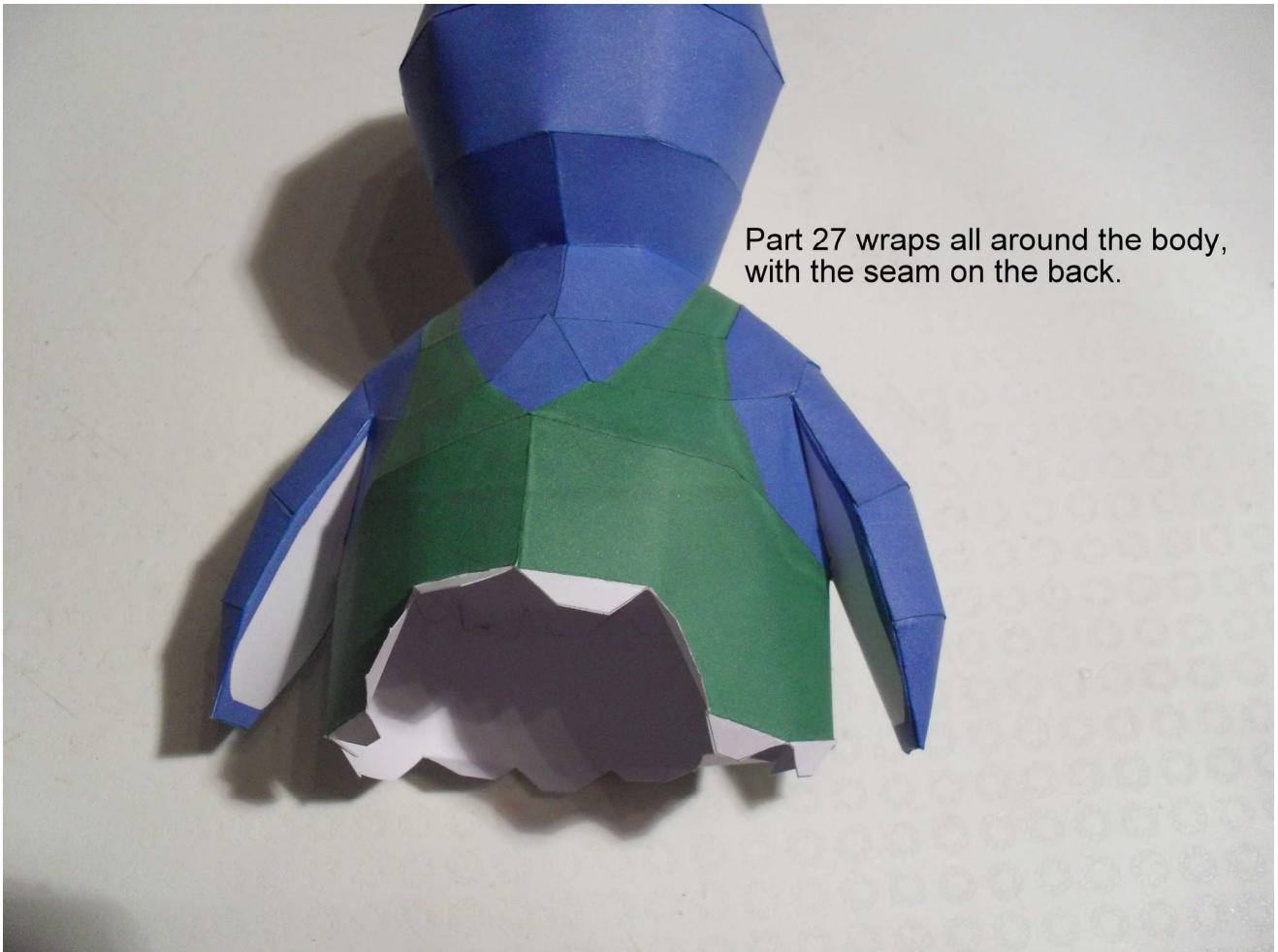


Add the buttons.



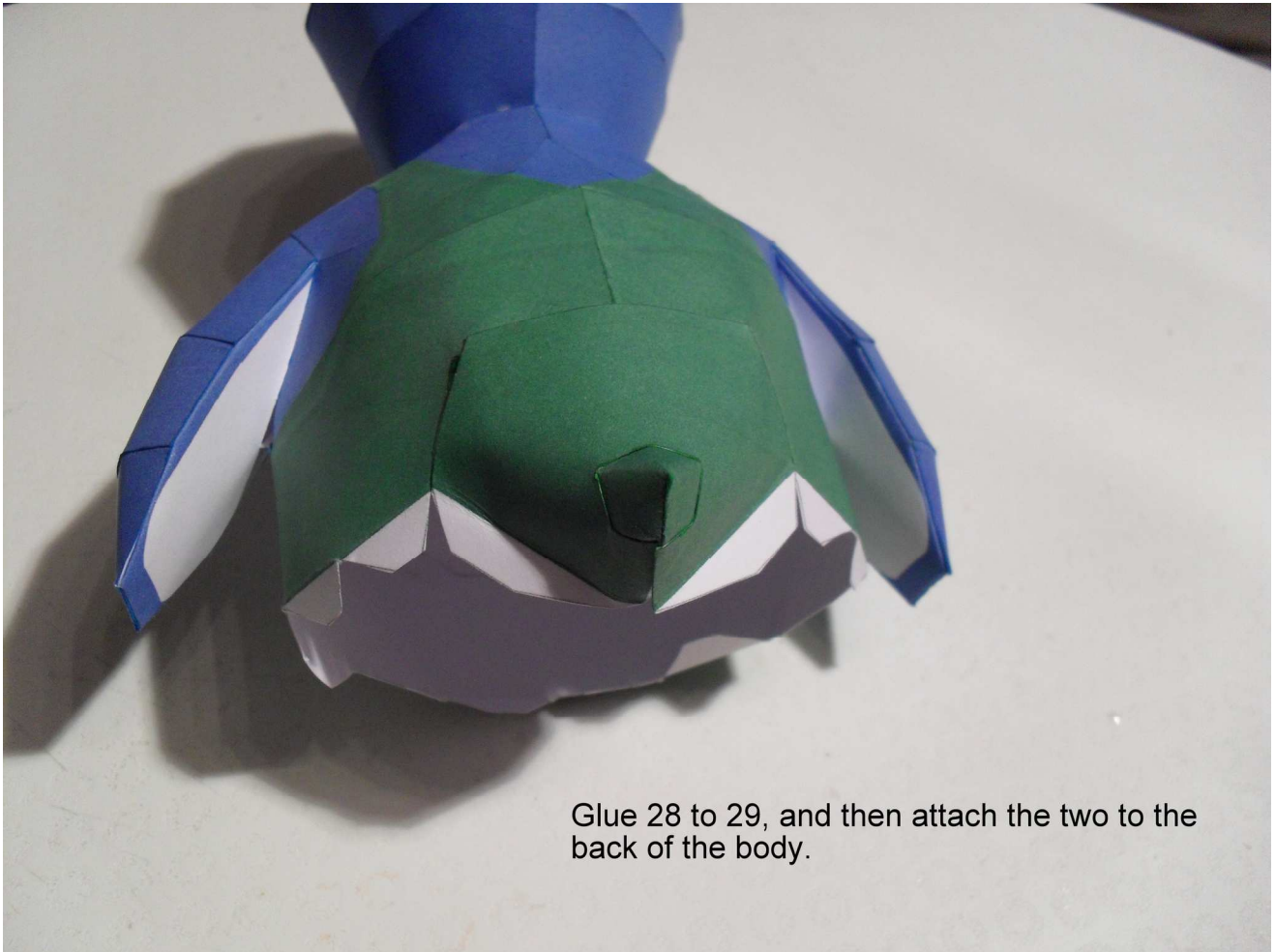


Part 26 attaches to the back.



Part 27 wraps all around the body, with the seam on the back.





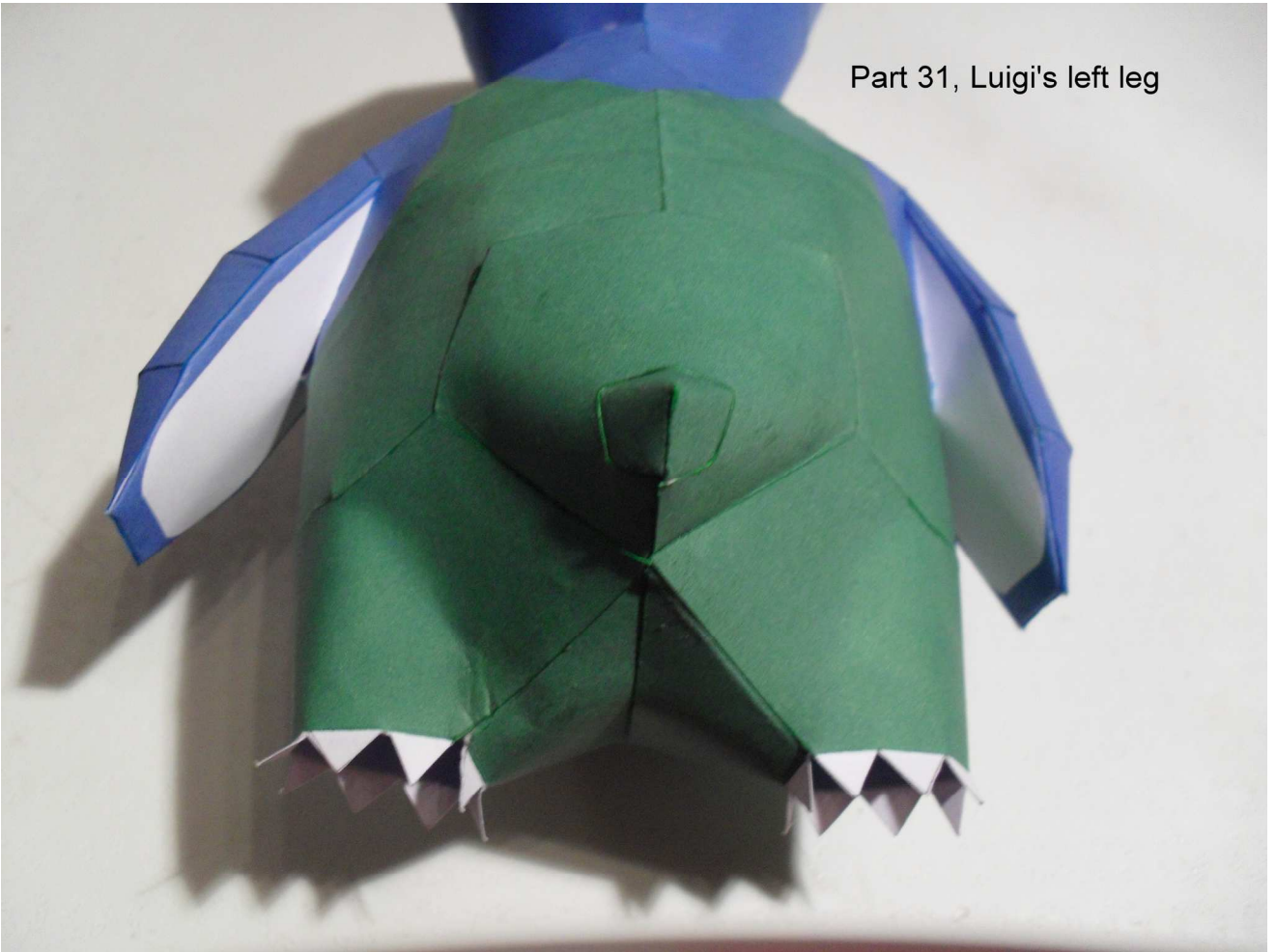
Glue 28 to 29, and then attach the two to the back of the body.



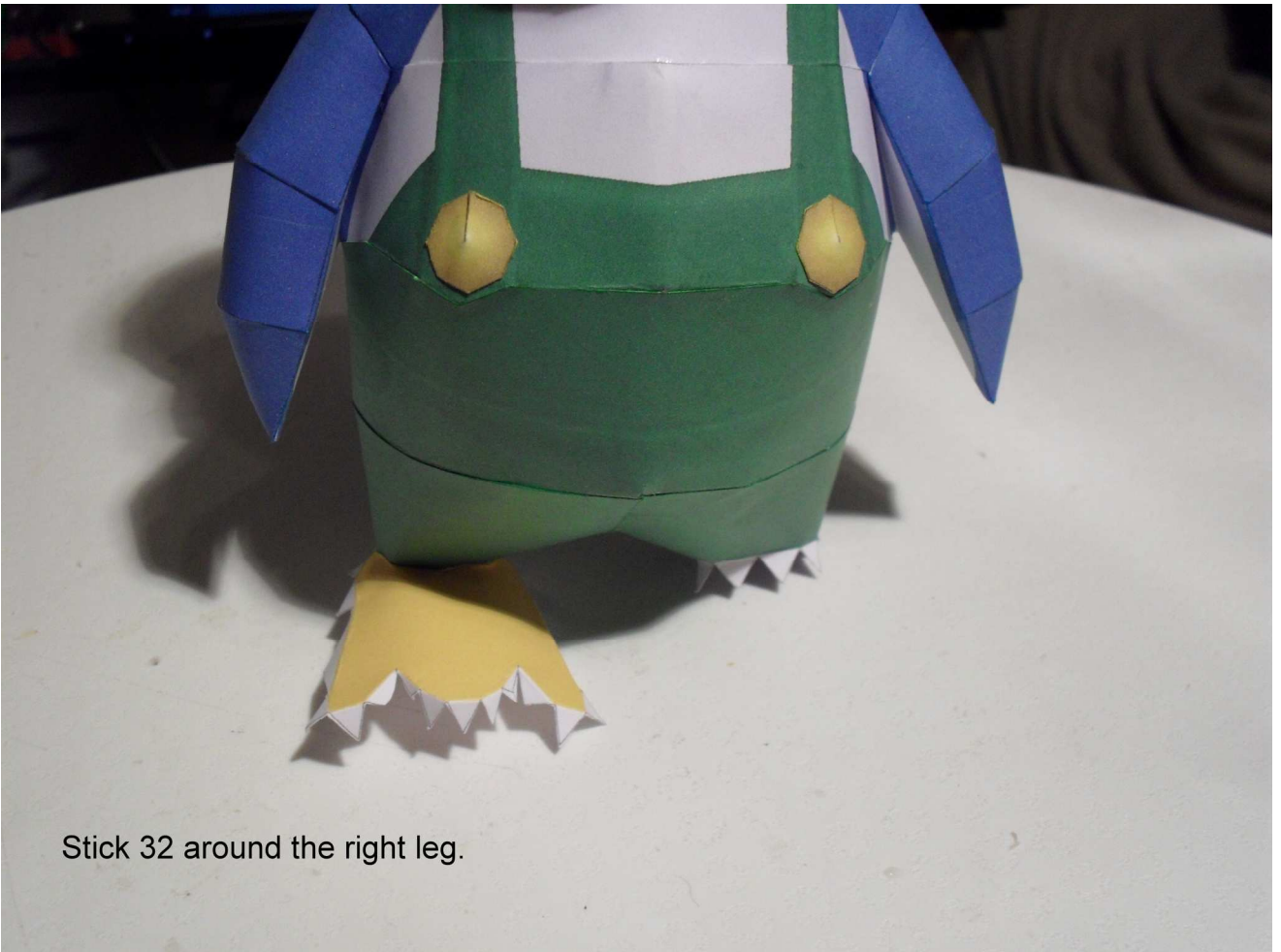
Part 30 is Luigi's right leg, the seam as shown.

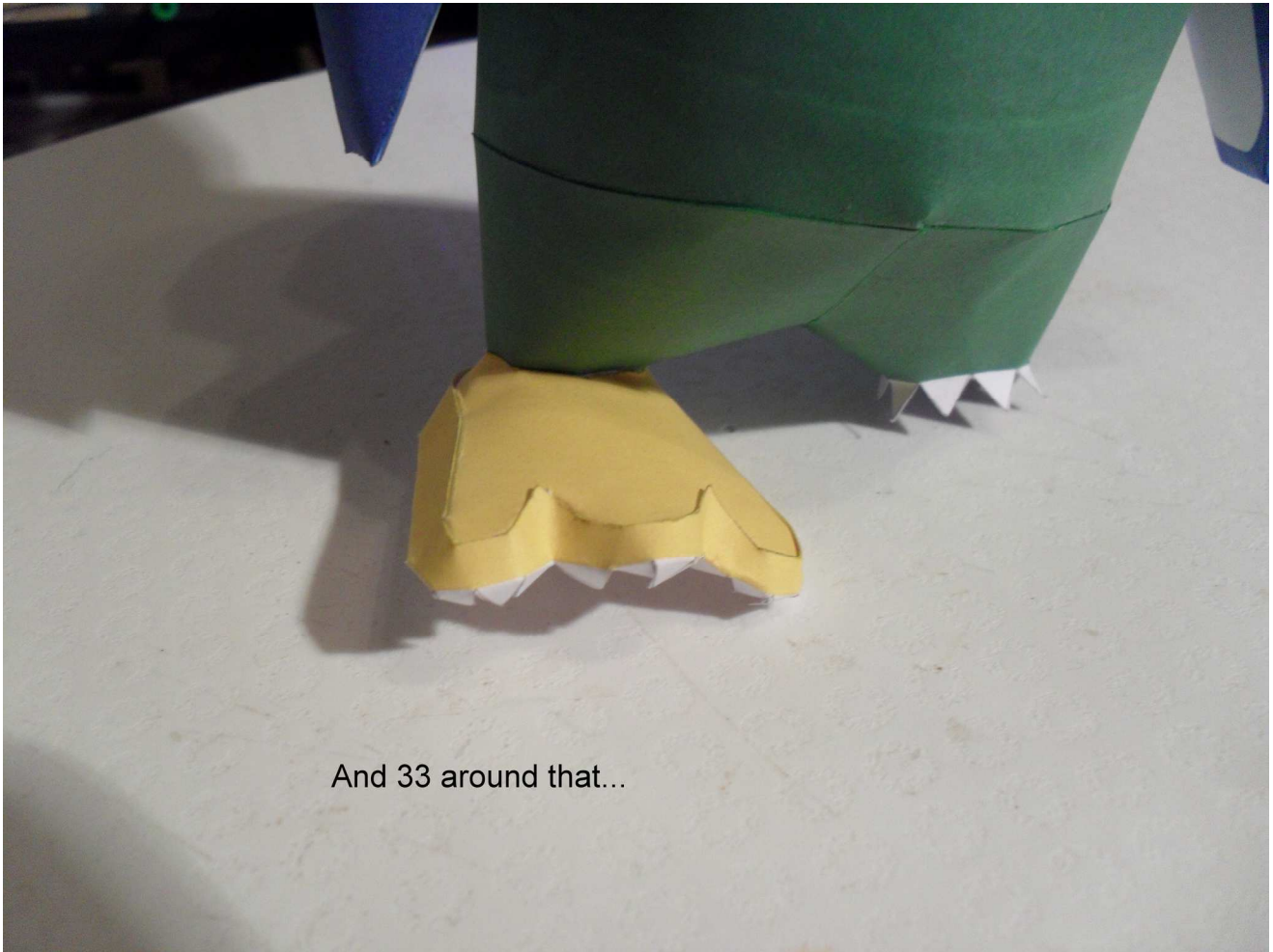


Part 31, Luigi's left leg

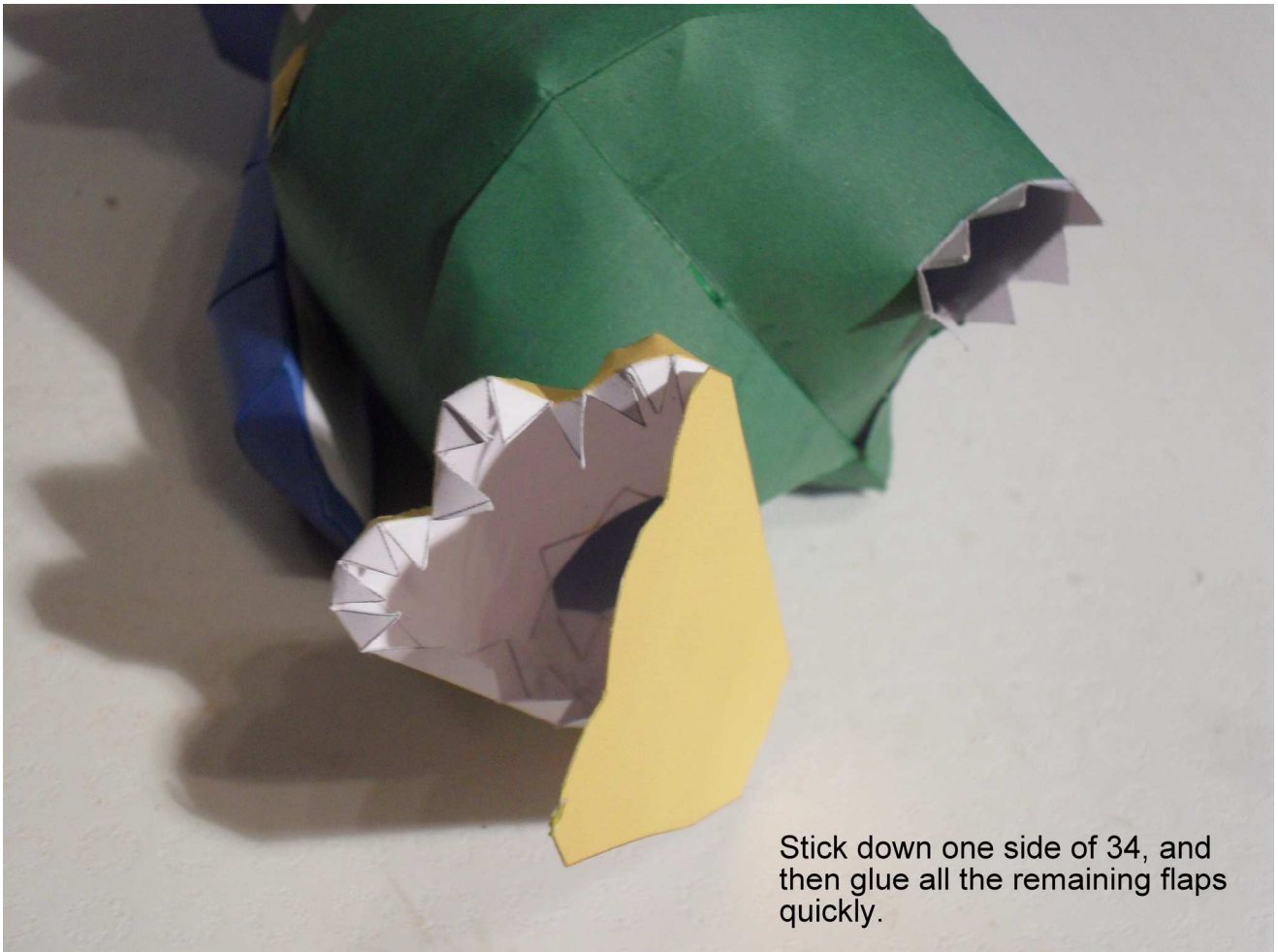


Stick 32 around the right leg.



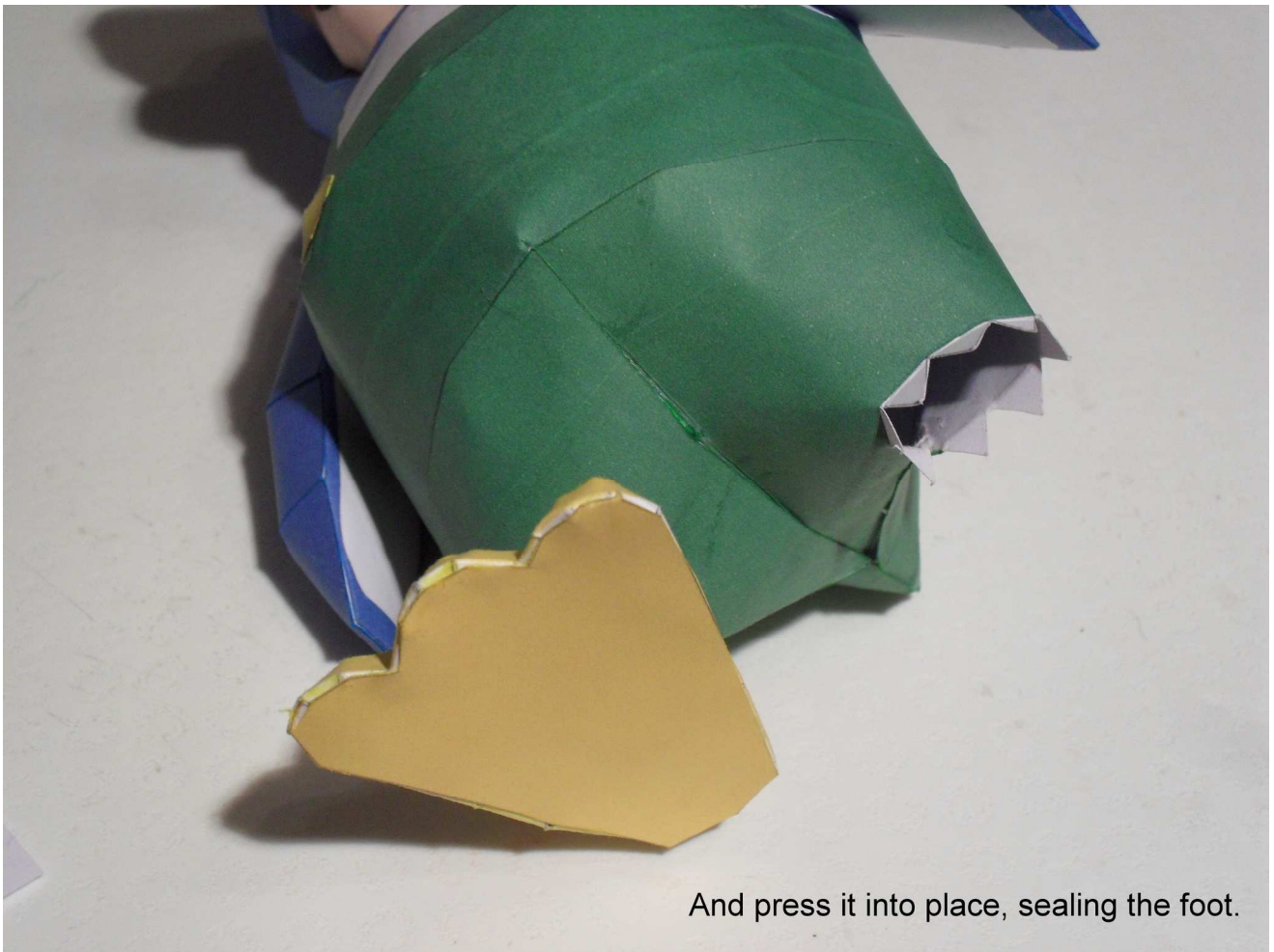


And 33 around that...



Stick down one side of 34, and then glue all the remaining flaps quickly.





And press it into place, sealing the foot.
